Small Group Questions

'Relationships 101 – Help! I Need Somebody'

Philippians 4:2-9

Can you list the steps of Biblical Peacemaking? (Matthew 18:15-17)

How do you know when you need to help a fellow Christian resolve a conflict or just ignore it? (Philippians 4:2-8)

Do you agree with this statement: "If you are estranged from a believer reading your bible or praying isn't enough?" (Matthew 18:15, Philippians 4:6,9)

When you are in conflict with a fellow Christian why is it important to remember you are on the same team? (Philippians 4:2)

Sometimes in conflict we are consumed thinking about how we have been wronged. Instead why does God's word teach us to "Rejoice in the Lord"?

When we are in conflict with someone we tend to focus on all the negatives. Why is it godly to instead think about their positive virtues? (Memorize Philippians 4:8)
