Ushers

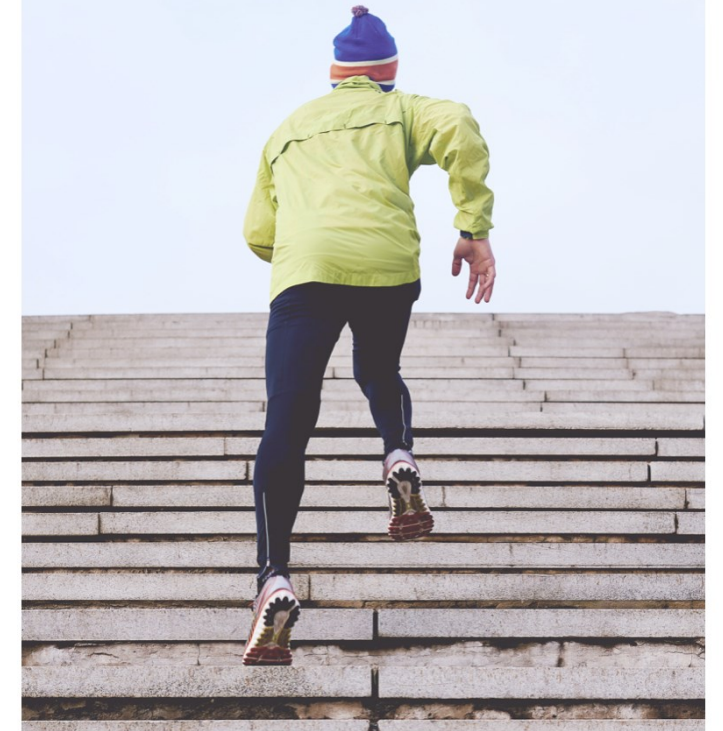
