

Sick Policy for Students and Teachers For Gibbsville Church – 2020/2021 school year

Out of consideration for each other and to help prevent the spread of sickness, the education committee is now asking that families/teachers please follow these guidelines for attending Sunday school or Bible class activities when sick. We have adopted the Oostburg Elementary School's sick policy for reference. This sick policy will be strictly enforced, so we ask everyone to work as a team and when in doubt, error on the side of caution. Thank you for your cooperation and consideration of each other!

Do not come yourself or send your child to Sunday school or Bible class if...

- 1. Must be 24 hours fever free without use of medication (Anything 100 degrees or higher)**
- 2. If participant has had diarrhea or vomiting within 24 hours. Also if complaints of stomach pain.**
- 3. Active productive coughing – Respect for this symptom is especially asked of younger children where coughing hygiene etiquette isn't consistent.**
- 4. nasal/sinus congestion/external flow (especially in younger children)**
- 5. Rash**
- 6. If on antibiotics, participant must be on 24 hours or as directed by a doctor to be symptom free.**
- 7. Difficulty breathing**
- 8. As per County Health Department, participant should stay home if **any 2** of the following are in occurrence: - loss of taste or smell**
 - Sore throat
 - Muscle/body ache
 - Chills/shivering
 - Fatigue/head ache
 - Congestion
 - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea

***If anyone in immediate family tests positive for Covid- 19 or is in quarantine, we ask that all immediate family members remain home during quarantine period.**

* If a student displays any symptoms above as listed, this child will gently be separated from the child's class with a supervisor and guardian/parent will be contacted and requested to come pick up child.
